Sunday 27th June 2010 - FITA 70 metre ranking round followed by a fun Olympic round team Head to Head

Timings for Both Days:

07:45 Registration opens both days
08:15 Assembly
08:30 Up to 45 minutes practice on the tournament field under control of the Judges.
Equipment inspection will be done during practice.
09:15 FITA 70 m ranking round - two details 4 archers per boss.

On completion of the FITA 70m ranking round (approximately 12:30), there will be a short break whilst archers are seeded for the Olympic round Head to Head element. This will be the only planned break on each day. Official practice for the afternoon session will be taken during this time. All archers will go into the head to head; higher placed archers will receive a bye in the earliest round.

The programme for the Olympic round will be published on the day. In all matches up to and including the Quarter-finals the archers will shoot simultaneously, the best of three, six arrow sets. In the semi-finals and finals, archers will alternate under the control of a match judge, the best of five, three arrow sets.

Team Allocation: Sunday archers will be grouped on their Saturday 70m scores by the organisers into teams of four either Compound or Recurve. Each team will shoot the 70m ranking round together on a boss. The teams will then be seeded according to their Sunday 70m team score before participating in the fun Team Head to Head element.

Awards: On completion of shooting on each day, the Guest of Honour will present the awards.

Target Awards: FITA Target Awards may be claimed by archers achieving the following scores for the FITA 70m round in accordance with FITA rules.

500-549	550-599	600-649	650-674	675-699	700+
white	black	blue	red	gold	purple

Dress: GNAS dress regulations as shown in GNAS Rule 307 will apply. Archers must wear plain dark green / white or officially registered alternative shooting colours. Archers are requested to observe the dress regulations until after the presentations

Drug Testing: Archers will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Entries from archers under 18 must be signed by a parent/guardian to signify their consent to their child being drug tested if approached.

Smoking: This is a non smoking event. If you have to partake, please retire well behind the tented area.

Caution: Please do not put hot stoves or burners directly on the grass.

Photography: In view of the provisions of the GNAS Policy for Safeguarding Children, Young People and Vulnerable Adults, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the Tournament Secretary on arrival. No unauthorised photography will be permitted.

GNAS Cards: Archers should have their GNAS membership cards available.

Lost arrows: All lost arrows **MUST** be reported to a judge or member of the field party. (Please remember to inform them if you later find the arrow). It is the responsibility of the archer to make sure that all arrows are accounted for before leaving the field.

Refreshments: The Thistle catering van will be available during each day. Please support them.

Caravans /Tents: Camping and caravanning space is available on site of £7.00 per unit per night. Please add this sum to your entry cheque.

Car Parking: For those archers attending on a daily basis, please use Wenlock Hall car park and transfer your kit using a trolley. It is quicker and a better road surface.

Target lists and results: Target lists and results will be published on the GNAS website at www.gnas.org/nationaltournaments/ and then click on National Summer Event. If absolutely necessary, paper copies of the target list and results can be sent; please enclose two stamped addressed C5 envelopes (9" x 6½") with your entry.

Entry fee: Both days £25.00, Single day £13.00. Cheques payable to GNAS. No refunds after the closing date.
