Shooting Order.

The 2 longest distances, gents 90/70 mtr, ladies 70/60 mtr & junior metric rounds will be shot in ends of 6 arrows on 122cm faces, within a timed period of 4 minutes.
The 2 shortest distances 50/30 mtr & junior metric rounds will be shot in ends of 3 arrows on 80cm faces, within a timed period of 2 minutes.
All arrow holes must be marked, even during practice.

Equipment.

Equipment inspection will be carried out during the shoot & will be done on a random basis. All arrows must be marked, making them recognisable by the archer & conforming to F.I.T.A. requirements.

Dress regulation 307 will apply.
